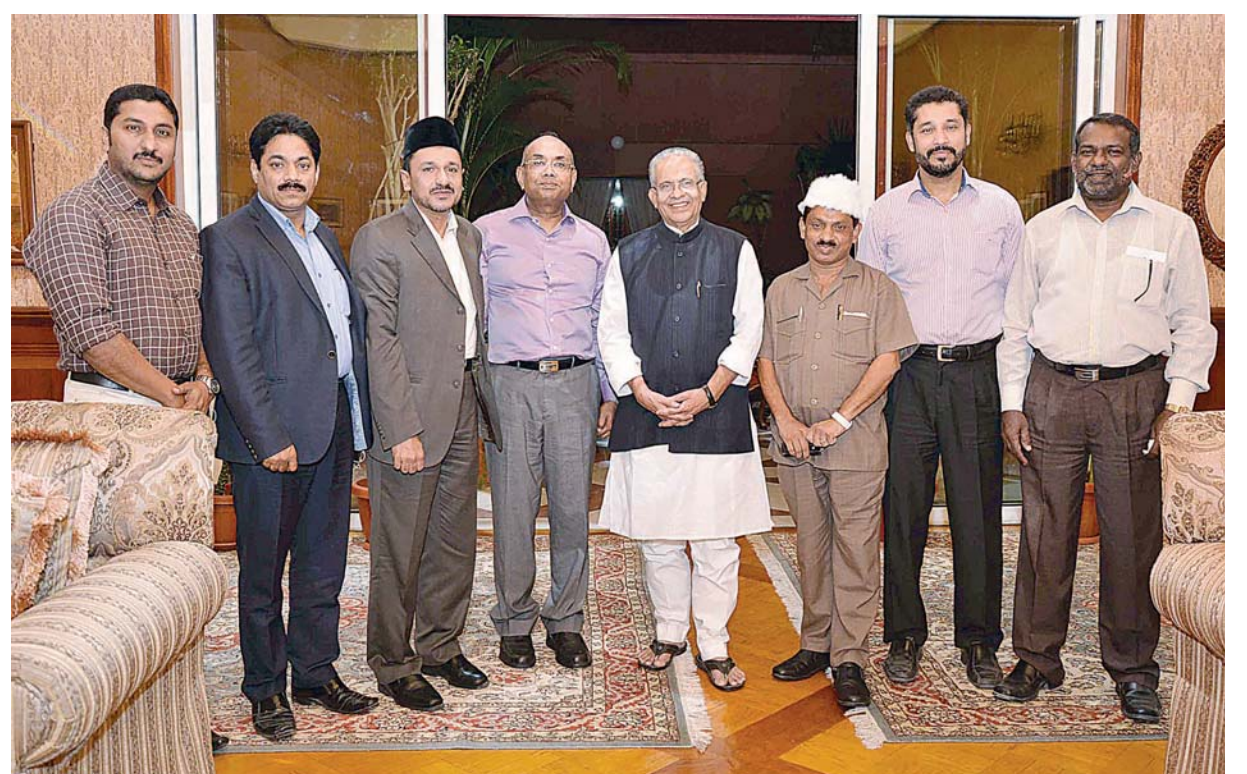
INDIAN MP, KMCC DELEGATION MEET AMBASSADOR
